



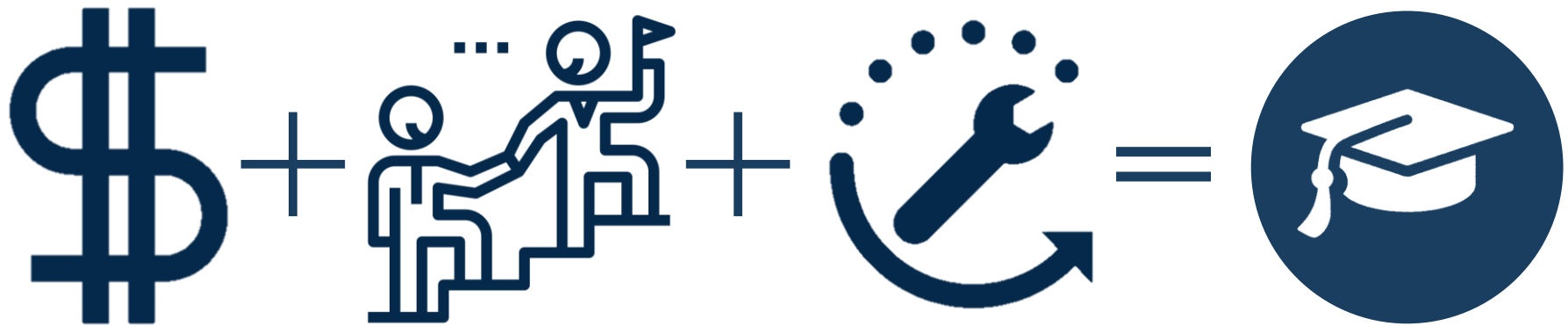

Dallas County Promise covers the cost of *tuition for up to three years or degree completion* (whichever comes first) at any Dallas County Community College (DCCCD) and a **Success Coach** for 2019 Dallas County high school graduates from participating campuses.

Dallas County Promise is built on three pillars to support student success

Three steps to have tuition covered & a Success Coach with Promise

Pledge & Apply

SENIOR YEAR by February 8:

- Make your Promise Pledge at www.DallasCountyPromise.org. Your pledge is only complete once you see a submission confirmation.
- Complete your admission application to a Promise partner college through ApplyTX or the college's admission application.

Submit

SENIOR YEAR by March 8:

- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and list a Promise Partner college or submit the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) to the colleges you want to attend.

Enroll

SENIOR YEAR by July 31:

- Register for classes at a Promise Partner college for the Fall semester.



Key University Partnerships



- **ALL** Dallas County Promise students
- **Tuition covered** (cost of classes)
- Must **meet Promise renewal requirements** (2.0 GPA, 18 credit hours per year)
- **Other Important Dates: December 1,** 2018 is the priority deadline to be accepted to UNTD Dallas and be considered for other competitive institutional scholarships
- Completion of Bachelor's degree or 3 years

- **Select** Dallas County Promise students
- **Tuition & fees covered** (cost of classes)
- Must meet **additional GPA and income requirements**
- **Other Important Dates: January 15,** 2019 is the deadline for Promise Pledge and additional materials for the SMU Mustang Scholars Program
- Completion of Bachelor's degree or 5 semesters

Key University Partnerships



- Families with AGI **less than \$50,000** AGI and Pell eligible
- Meet **Promise deadlines**
- **Tuition covered** (cost of classes)
- Must **meet Promise renewal requirements** (2.0 GPA, 18 credit hours per year)
- Completion of Bachelor's degree or 3 years

Promise Benefits to Students

1. Regardless of what FAFSA/TASFA comes back with, Promise students are ***guaranteed to have their tuition covered at any DCCCD campus***
2. For **ALL** students at the 43 participating high schools regardless of income or high school GPA (and no essays!)
3. Promise Pledge also counts as DCCCD Rising Star scholarship application; students will ***automatically receive book stipend*** at DCCCD if they meet additional income and GPA requirements

Promise Benefits to Students (cont.)

4. Promise ***Pledge must be complete by February 8*** to receive Promise and/or Rising Star scholarships (*including parent signature for students under 18*)
5. Promise staff support during senior year & proactive college ***Success Coach support*** beginning at the end of senior year and continuing through college transfer/completion
6. Access to additional university ***transfer scholarships*** at UNT Dallas and SMU

Adding Promise Pledge to DCCCD Admissions File

eConnect Validation Steps

After submitting their Promise Pledge and admissions application to a DCCCD college, students will need to:

1. Receive DCCCD ID
2. Setup eConnect account
3. Log into eConnect
4. Navigate to Current Credit Students Menu
5. Follow Dallas Promise Student Pledge link
6. Enter High school name, HS ID, DOB, and Pledge ID

Must be validated by February 8, 2019



eConnect Validation FAQs

Does validating my pledge mean I'm committing to go to DCCCD?

No, validating is adding your Pledge data to your admissions file to remain eligible. You can still decide over the summer if you want to attend/use Promise.

If I already have a DCCCD ID (from dual credit, etc.) can I go straight to validation?

As long as you have a DCCCD ID, have set up eConnect, and have completed your pledge you are free to validate!

Here are your next steps to become a Dallas County Promise Scholar:

- Complete an admissions application for the Promise Partner Colleges you're considering at ApplyTexas.org or at the partner college's website such as dcccd.edu/apply.
- If you are considering one of the Dallas County Community Colleges, you will be required to set up your eConnect account in order to validate your Promise Pledge using your unique Pledge ID number. For a direct link to the validation page and to retrieve your Pledge ID log into your Promise Pledge account.

By February 8, 2019*

- Submit the 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.gov and list the college(s) you are interested in.
OR

- Students that qualify for [in-state tuition](#) who are non-citizens or have DACA/Dreamer status should print the 2019-2020 Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) from <http://tiny.cc/TASFAform> and submit directly to the schools' financial aid departments.

By July 31, 2019

- Register for Fall 2019 classes at a Promise Partner College

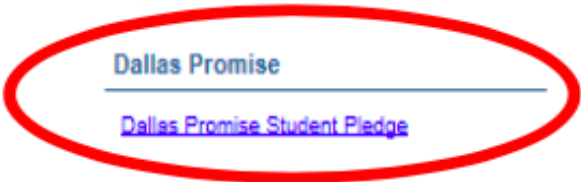
