You've earned your associate degree--what's next? The Dallas County Promise is an option for YOU. Earn your bachelor's degree without ever paying a cent for tuition. Plus, you'll have the support of a Success Coach to help you navigate college and career. Your grades and household income don't disqualify you and we don't lock you into a commitment in case you have other ideas.

Here's how to become eligible:

TAKE THE PLEDGE & APPLY TO COLLEGE

BY FEBRUARY 7, 2020:

- Complete your "Promise Pledge" at DallasCountyPromise.org. Remember: The pledge does not commit you to any university or career pathway. This is only to confirm your eligibility for the last-dollar scholarship offer.
- Submit an admission application to a Promise partner college or university through ApplyTexas.org or the school website.

SUBMIT YOUR FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION

BY MARCH 6, 2020:

- Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) and list the Promise partner colleges or universities you plan to attend.

ENROLL IN COURSES

BY July 31, 2020:

- Complete registration and select your courses for the Fall 2020 semester.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Each partner college and university has a unique priority deadline to be considered for additional institutional scholarships. Visit www.dallascountypromise.org/students/college-partners for more info.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

With four steps:

1. Take the pledge by February 7, 2020
2. Apply to the Promise partner college or university of your choice
3. Submit a financial aid application (FAFSA or TASFA),
& Enroll in courses by July 31, 2020
