Overview

University of North Texas at Dallas (UNT Dallas) provides eligible students from participating high schools the opportunity to be part of Dallas County Promise Program. Students selected to be part of the program will be offered a last-dollar grant that (combined with other need-based grants and scholarships) funds state-mandated and board-designated tuition.



Grant Limit
Any student who meets deadlines and eligibility below



Income Limit
\$85,000 or less Adjusted Gross Income



Maximum Eligibility

High school diploma:

Up to four (4) consecutive years or bachelor's degree completion

Transfer:

Up to three (3) consecutive years or bachelor's degree completion

Dallas County Promise Deadlines

FEB 5, 2025: Submit Promise Path Form

- Please include an email address you regularly check and phone number to receive program text messages.
- You'll receive a confirmation email with your Promise ID. Please keep for your records.

MAY 1, 2025: Apply for Admission and Financial Aid

- Submit a complete **Fall 2025** admission application to UNT Dallas.
- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to UNT Dallas.
 - **Federal School Code: 042421**
 - Ensure your full name, date of birth, high school, social security number (if applicable) and list of colleges is correct and updated.
- Regularly check your **myUNTD** portal for the most updated status on your admissions and financial aid applications.

AUG 5, 2025: Register for Fall 2025 classes

Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ Attend a participating high school for the full 2024-2025 school year and graduate in the current school year.
- ✓ Meet all Dallas County Promise program deadlines for Promise Path, admission application, financial aid application, orientation, and enrollment.
- ✓ **Have a Family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$85,000 or less, as reported on FAFSA or TASFA.**
- ✓ Must be a Texas resident for tuition purposes.
- ✓ Must start classes the fall semester after high school graduation.
- ✓ Students graduating in December 2024 are Promise eligible; however, Promise funding does not begin until the 2025 Fall semester following high school graduation for those who qualify.

2024-2025 Transfer and Renewal Requirements

University of North Texas at Dallas

Transfer Students

Students who enter a Dallas College campus under Promise and maintain Promise eligibility with at least a 2.0 GPA on transferrable credit and meet other key criteria will be considered for a last-dollar, tuition-only grant to UNT Dallas. Funding is limited and students are prioritized based on date of admission. Students wishing to transfer to UNT Dallas before completing an Associate degree are eligible to receive Promise funding. Students will be encouraged to complete the reverse transfer process to earn their Associate degree. **Transfer eligibility criteria include but are not limited to:**

- ✓ Beginning July 1 in the year prior to transfer (i.e. July 1, 2024 if starting Fall 2025) and no later than May 1st (i.e. May 1, 2025 if starting Fall 2025) Promise Transfer Scholars must complete the steps outline below.
- ✓ Have a Family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$85,000 or less as established by FAFSA or TASFA.

For the full list of transfer eligibility criteria, please review the UNT Dallas Transfer Enrollment section of the 24-25 DCP Policies & Procedures document. Transfer students who do not meet the Dallas County Promise application deadlines and eligibility criteria will be responsible for all tuition and fees not covered by scholarships and/or financial aid. International students currently are not eligible to receive the tuition benefit at UNT Dallas through the Dallas County Promise program.

TRANSFER FALL 2025

MAY 1, 2025: Apply for Admission

- Student is encouraged to be accepted for admission, including submitting official transcripts from all previously attended and/or currently enrolled colleges/universities.

MAY 1, 2025: Apply for Financial Aid

- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to UNT Dallas.
 - **Federal School Code: 042421**

TRANSFER SPRING 2026

Apply for Admission

- Student is encouraged to be accepted for admission, including submitting official transcripts from all previously attended and/or currently enrolled colleges/universities.

Apply for Financial Aid

- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to UNT Dallas.
 - **Federal School Code: 042421**

Renewal Requirements

Once a student is selected for the Dallas County Promise program at the University of North Texas at Dallas, they must maintain specific criteria in order to continue receiving the last-dollar tuition grant. **The renewal criteria include but are not limited to:**

- ✓ Enroll and earn at least **24 semester credit hours** for the academic year.
- ✓ Maintain a **2.0 cumulative GPA and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)** at the end of the academic year. GPA is calculated at the end of each term.
- ✓ High School Diploma Students: Complete a bachelor's degree within four (4) years of enrollment at UNT Dallas.
+ Associate Degree and Transfer Students: Complete a bachelor's degree within three (3) years of enrollment at UNT Dallas.
