









FALL 2025 TRANSFER OFFER

For Dallas College Students

REFERENCE GUIDE: Any student who submitted a Promise Path, irrespective of receiving the Dallas County Promise last-dollar tuition grant at any point while enrolled at Dallas College, who meets the eligibility criteria outlined, can qualify to receive the Dallas County Promise transfer last-dollar tuition grant at a partner university to cover any gap in the cost of tuition not covered by need-based aid + scholarships. This grant does not cover the full cost of attendance (housing, meals, etc.).

UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED:

- students wishing to transfer to a partner university before completing an associate degree are ineligible
- a 2.0 or above GPA required for transfer admission
- grant is renewable for up to four (4) academic semesters contingent on annual renewal requirements
- student must be enrolled full-time
- transferable associate degree includes Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, and Associate of Arts in Teaching
- no cap or limit on the number of students who can qualify for this grant (contingent on meeting eligibility requirements)
- deadlines are for complete admission and financial aid application files (supporting documents must be processed)
- international students are current not eligible for this grant
