

# 2024-2025 Requirements for Graduating Seniors

## Tarleton State University



### Overview

Tarleton State University (TSU) provides eligible students from participating high schools the opportunity to be part of Dallas County Promise Program. Students selected to be part of the program will be offered a last-dollar grant that (combined with other need-based grants and scholarships) funds state-mandated and board-designated tuition.



**Grant Limit**  
Any student who meets deadlines and eligibility below



**Income Limit**  
\$85,000 or less Adjusted Gross Income



**Maximum Eligibility**  
High school diploma:  
Up to eight (8) semesters/four (4) years or bachelor's degree completion  
Transfer:  
Up to four (4) semesters/two (2) years or bachelor's degree completion

### Dallas County Promise Deadlines

#### FEB 5, 2025: Submit Promise Path Form

- Please include an email address you regularly check and phone number to receive program text messages.
- You'll receive a confirmation email with your Promise ID. Please keep for your records.

#### MAR 1, 2025: Apply for Admission and Financial Aid

- Submit a complete **Fall 2025** admission application to TSU.
- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to TSU, *based on eligibility*.
  - **Federal School Code: 003631**
  - Ensure your full name, date of birth, high school, social security number (if applicable) and list of colleges is correct and updated.
- Regularly check your **myGateway** portal for the most updated status on your admissions and financial aid applications.

#### AUG 5, 2025: Register for Fall 2025 classes

### Promise Tuition Grant Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ **Have a Family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$85,000 or less.**
- ✓ Attend a participating high school for the full 2024-2025 school year and graduate in the current school year.
- ✓ Meet all Dallas County Promise program deadlines for Promise Path, admission application, financial aid application, orientation, and enrollment.
- ✓ Must be admitted to TSU in the top 50% of graduating high school class. If the high school doesn't rank, TSU will use other factors to determine top quarter equivalent standing (primarily high school GPA).
- ✓ Successful completion and submission of the Tarleton Scholarship Application.
- ✓ Must be a U.S. citizen and Texas resident for tuition purposes.
- ✓ Must start classes the fall semester after high school graduation.
- ✓ Must enroll at TSU full-time.

# 2024-2025 Transfer and Renewal Requirements

## Tarleton State University

### Transfer Students

Scholars who remain Dallas County Promise eligible and complete an associate degree from Dallas College with at least a 2.0 GPA and other key criteria can receive a last-dollar, tuition-only grant to TSU. Students wishing to transfer to TSU before completing an associate degree are ineligible to receive a Dallas County Promise award. **Transfer eligibility criteria include but are not limited to:**

- ✓ Enroll at TSU the Fall or Spring semester after graduation from Dallas College with their transferable associate degree (Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Arts in Teaching).
- ✓ Have a Family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$85,000.

**For the full list of transfer eligibility criteria, please review the TSU Transfer Enrollment section of the 24-25 DCP Policies & Procedures document. Transfer students who do not meet the Dallas County Promise application deadlines and eligibility criteria will be responsible for all tuition and fees not covered by scholarships and/or financial aid. International students currently are not eligible to receive the tuition benefit at TSU through the Dallas County Promise program.**

#### TRANSFER FALL 2025

##### Apply for Admission

- Student must be accepted for admission to TSU, by June 1, prior to the Fall semester of the year in which the student intends to transfer.

##### Apply for Financial Aid

- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to TSU each year by the priority deadline of January 15 (final date to apply is March 1).
  - **Federal School Code: 003631**

#### TRANSFER SPRING 2026

##### Apply for Admission

- Submit must be accepted for admission to TSU, by December 1, prior to the Spring semester of the year in which the student intends to transfer

##### Apply for Financial Aid

- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to TSU each year by the priority deadline of January 15 (final date to apply is March 1).
  - **Federal School Code: 003631**

### Renewal Requirements

Once a student is selected for the Dallas County Promise program at Tarleton State University, they must maintain specific criteria in order to continue receiving the last-dollar tuition grant. **The renewal criteria include but are not limited to:**

- ✓ Enroll in and earn **at least 12 credit hours** each Fall and Spring semester (non-TSU enrolled hours not included).
- ✓ Maintain a **minimum** TSU cumulative grade point average (**GPA**) of **2.0** to be checked at the end of each Fall and Spring semester and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) as set forth in the TSU Undergraduate Catalog.
- ✓ Maintain a **Family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$85,000 or less.**
- ✓ High School Diploma Students: Complete a bachelor's degree within four (4) years of enrollment at TSU.  
**+ Associate Degree and Transfer Students:** Complete a bachelor's degree within two (2) years of enrollment at TSU.
