

# 2024-2025 Requirements for Graduating Seniors

## University of North Texas



### Overview

The University of North Texas (UNT) provides eligible students from participating high schools the opportunity to be part of Dallas County Promise Program. Eligible students will be offered a last-dollar award that (combined with other need-based grants and scholarships) funds tuition and mandatory fees.



**Grant Limit**  
Any student who meets deadlines and eligibility below



**Income Limit**  
Pell grant eligible or TASFA equivalent AND \$85,000 or less Adjusted Gross Income



**Maximum Eligibility**  
High school diploma:  
Up to eight (8) semesters/four (4) years or bachelor's degree completion  
Transfer:  
Up to four (4) semesters/two (2) years or bachelor's degree completion

### Dallas County Promise Deadlines

#### FEB 5, 2025: Submit Promise Path Form

- Please include an email address you regularly check and phone number to receive program text messages.
- You'll receive a confirmation email with your Promise ID. Please keep for your records.

#### FEB 15, 2025: Apply for Admission

- Submit a complete **Fall 2025** admission application to UNT through [ApplyTexas](#) or [CommonApp](#).

#### MAR 1, 2025: Apply for Financial Aid

- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to UNT, *based on eligibility*.
  - **Federal School Code: 003594**
  - Ensure your full name, date of birth, high school, social security number (if applicable) and list of colleges is correct and updated.
- Regularly check your [myUNT](#) portal for the most updated status on your admissions and financial aid applications.

**AUG 5, 2025: Register for Fall 2025 classes**

### Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ Attend a participating high school for the full 2024-2025 school year and graduate in the current school year.
- ✓ Meet all Dallas County Promise program deadlines for Promise Path, admission application, financial aid application, orientation, and enrollment.
- ✓ Must qualify for TEXAS grant program.
- ✓ **Have a Total Family Income of \$85,000 or less AND Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$6472 or less.**
- ✓ Must be a Texas resident for tuition purposes.
- ✓ Must start classes the fall semester after high school graduation.

# 2024-2025 Transfer and Renewal Requirements

## University of North Texas

### Transfer Students

Scholars who remain Dallas County Promise eligible and complete an associate degree from Dallas College with at least a 2.5 GPA and other key criteria can receive a last-dollar, tuition-only grant to UNT. Students wishing to transfer to UNT before completing an associate degree are ineligible to receive a Dallas County Promise award. **Transfer eligibility criteria include but are not limited to:**

- ✓ Enroll at UNT the Fall or Spring semester after graduation from Dallas College with their transferable associate degree (Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Arts in Teaching).
- ✓ Must meet eligibility criteria for TEXAS Grant program and have a Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$6472 or less as established by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA). Total family income must be \$85,000 or less.

**For the full list of transfer eligibility criteria, please review the UNT Transfer Enrollment section of the 2024-2025 DCP Policies & Procedures document. Transfer students must meet the Dallas County Promise application deadlines and eligibility criteria to be considered for the Dallas County Promise tuition and fees award. International students are not eligible to receive the tuition and fees award at UNT through the Dallas County Promise program.**

#### TRANSFER FALL 2025

##### MAR 1, 2025: Apply for Admission and Financial Aid

- Student must be accepted for admission to UNT by March 1, including submitting official transcripts from all previously attended and/or currently enrolled colleges/universities.
- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to UNT, including the submission of all required documents if chosen for verification.
  - **Federal School Code: 003594**

#### TRANSFER SPRING 2026

##### MAY 1, 2025: Apply for Financial Aid

- Complete a **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (**TASFA**) to UNT, including the submission of all required documents if chosen for verification.
  - **Federal School Code: 003594**

##### DEC 1, 2025: Apply for Admission

- Student must be accepted for admission to UNT by December 1, including submitting official transcripts from all previously attended and/or currently enrolled colleges/universities.

### Renewal Requirements

Once a student is selected for the Dallas County Promise program at UNT, they must maintain specific criteria in order to continue receiving the last-dollar tuition grant. **The renewal criteria include but are not limited to:**

- ✓ Complete **12 or more credit hours** each Fall and Spring semester (non-UNT enrolled hours are not included).
- ✓ Successfully complete at the end of each academic year at least **24 semester credit hours** at UNT.
- ✓ Maintain a **minimum** UNT cumulative grade point average (**GPA**) of **2.5** at the end of each Fall and Spring semester.
- ✓ Maintain eligibility for the TEXAS Grant program and have a Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$6472 or less.
- ✓ High School Diploma Students: Complete a bachelor's degree within four (4) years of enrollment at UNT.  
+ Associate Degree and Transfer Students: Complete a bachelor's degree within two (2) years of enrollment at UNT.
