Most of our partners have **NO ESSAY requirement**, and some partners also have **NO INCOME or GPA requirement** to apply. You may have the option to attend a Promise partner university directly, or after earning your associate degree at Dallas College, you have the option to transfer to a partner university to earn your bachelor’s degree with any tuition gap entirely covered! 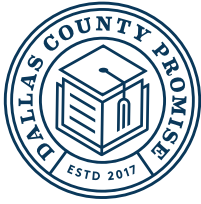

We have college partners that don't require specific grades or household income, and we don't lock you into a commitment in case you have other ideas for life after high school.

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## Am I Eligible?

- The Dallas County Promise Pledge opens for graduating high school seniors (Class of 2022) on September 1, 2021

**Submit your pledge by February 2, 2022**



Submit your "Promise Pledge" at [DallasCountyPromise.org](http://DallasCountyPromise.org). Remember: The Pledge does NOT commit you to any university or career pathway. This is only to confirm your eligibility for the last-dollar (tuition gap funding) scholarship offer.

**3/1/22**

**Apply to college & submit your financial aid application by March 1, 2022**



Submit an admissions application to a Promise partner college or university through [ApplyTexas.org](http://ApplyTexas.org) or the partner's website.



Submit the **2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** or **Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA)** and list the Promise partner colleges or universities you are considering to attend.

**7/27/22**

**Register for courses by July 27, 2022**



Select your courses and complete registration for the Fall 2022 semester.
